This 6 hour Intermediate course (CCGL Level 2) is **free** to teachers (QTS) working in all state-funded schools. It is suitable for teachers of all phases and all subjects, particularly useful to International/Global Coordinators and those holding responsibility for Eco-Schools, SMSC, Fairtrade, Citizenship etc

The **Global Teachers Award** promotes skills, confidence and practical approaches to incorporate global learning into the curriculum, and active global citizenship into the school.

- *Global Concepts - exploring the fundamentals of global learning*
- *Perspectives - questioning pupils' and teachers' assumptions*
- *Approaches to Learning - developing critical thinking skills*
- *Applying learning - in the classroom, the curriculum and beyond*
- *Measuring change - tools for evaluating impact*

To achieve Level 1, teachers attend the face to face training, undertake a global learning activity with their class then critically reflect.
