NOCN Level 3 Certificate for Forest School Leaders

Course fee: £850

Who is it for ?

Those working with children and young people who wish to deliver forest school programmes. You must be 19 years old or over to begin the course and 21 years old or over to complete the course.

What does it involve?

- 10 days of training, 10am-3pm, at Hamsterley Forest with some sessions on Zoom.
- Delivery of 6 forest school sessions over 6 weeks at your own site.
- Completion of a comprehensive portfolio of evidence and reflection— learners have 12 months from the beginning of the course to complete their portfolio.
- Face to face days will follow current Coronavirus procedures including distancing and hand sanitising

What will you learn?

The qualification includes 5 units:

- Forest School Programme: Planning and Preparation
- Forest School Programme: Delivery
- Forest School Programme: Learning and development
- Forest School Programme: Practical skills (including fires, tools, knots and shelters)
- Forest School Programme: The woodland environment

How do I book?

- Complete and return our booking form.
- We recommend that you also complete a 2 day forest school / paediatric first aid qualification. We can provide details of courses that are available.
- We also recommend that you complete food hygiene and safeguarding training.

What should I bring?

- Outdoor clothing including a waterproof coat, waterproof trousers and warm layers.
- Sturdy footwear—steel toe cap boots are recommended.
